

## How to Appeal Your SFE Funded Non-Medical Help Support

If you think a decision Student Finance England (SFE) have made in relation to your assessment of need is incorrect for any of the following support assistance, you may have the right to appeal if you are dissatisfied with the type of support being offered, the provider of the support or the amount of assistance awarded.

- 1-1 Study Skills Support
- Specialist Mentoring
- British Sign Language Support
- Language Support for Deaf Students

You may request assistance in making an appeal to SFE by making an appointment with one of our Disability Adviser's. Any appeal to SFE must come from the student directly together with any supporting evidence.

If you require assistance with your appeal from the Disability Advisory Service you can contact us in the following ways:-
